# Our Story

Founded in 1983, Merryvale Vineyards is the quintessential St. Helena destination. Located in the heart of the Napa Valley, Merryvale employs sustainable farming practices and superior standards in the vineyards and winery to ensure that the wines live up to their full potential. Merryvale's portfolio boasts complex, balanced and classic wines that are truly reflective of the region's terroir. The main varieties include Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Merlot, and Sauvignon Blanc.

Helmed by the Schlatter family for over 30 years, Merryvale has established deep roots with ownership of sustainably farmed estate vineyards: The Profile Estate, a 25-acre hillside vineyard overlooking St. Helena; 17 acres on Mt. Veeder and 13 acres in Coombsville.



# The Schlatters

Swiss born, René Schlatter upholds his family's integrity as Proprietor and CEO of Merryvale Vineyards since 2008 when he took the helm from his father overseeing all aspects of the day-to-day business.

René's wife, Laurence, also comes from a family of several generations in winemaking. Ownership of Merryvale provides a special sense of tradition for her. "It's very rewarding to continue this family heritage at Merryvale," says Laurence.

Active in the community and with their three daughters, Laurence focuses on the guest experience at Merryvale.

For nearly three decades, the Schlatter Family's dedication to quality has propelled Merryvale forward, producing an unparalleled Bordeaux-focused portfolio of complex, balanced and classic wines that are truly reflective of the region's terroir. Coupled with sustainable farming practices, both values support the Schlatter Family's commitment to the environment and to future generations.

# The Winemaking Team

The Schlatters have assembled a stellar winemaking team headed by Winemaker Jeff Crawford, who has worked with the family since 2007. With a winemaking degree from U.C. Davis, Jeff is considered the “encyclopedia” of Merryvale, with deep wisdom and experience with its vineyards and wines. Joining him is Associate Winemaker Matteo Fecondo, who fell in love with winemaking in his native Italy and held harvest positions in New Zealand and Australia before arriving in Napa Valley.

The winemaking team also includes revered consulting winemaker, Jean Hoefliger. Jean, a fellow countryman and friend of the Schlatters for many years, brings a sensibility to Merryvale perfectly matched to René and Laurence’s own. His awe for the vineyard properties they have acquired, appreciation of the team they have gathered and his desire to create wines that stand the test of time align utterly with the vision René and Laurence have for Merryvale Vineyards.

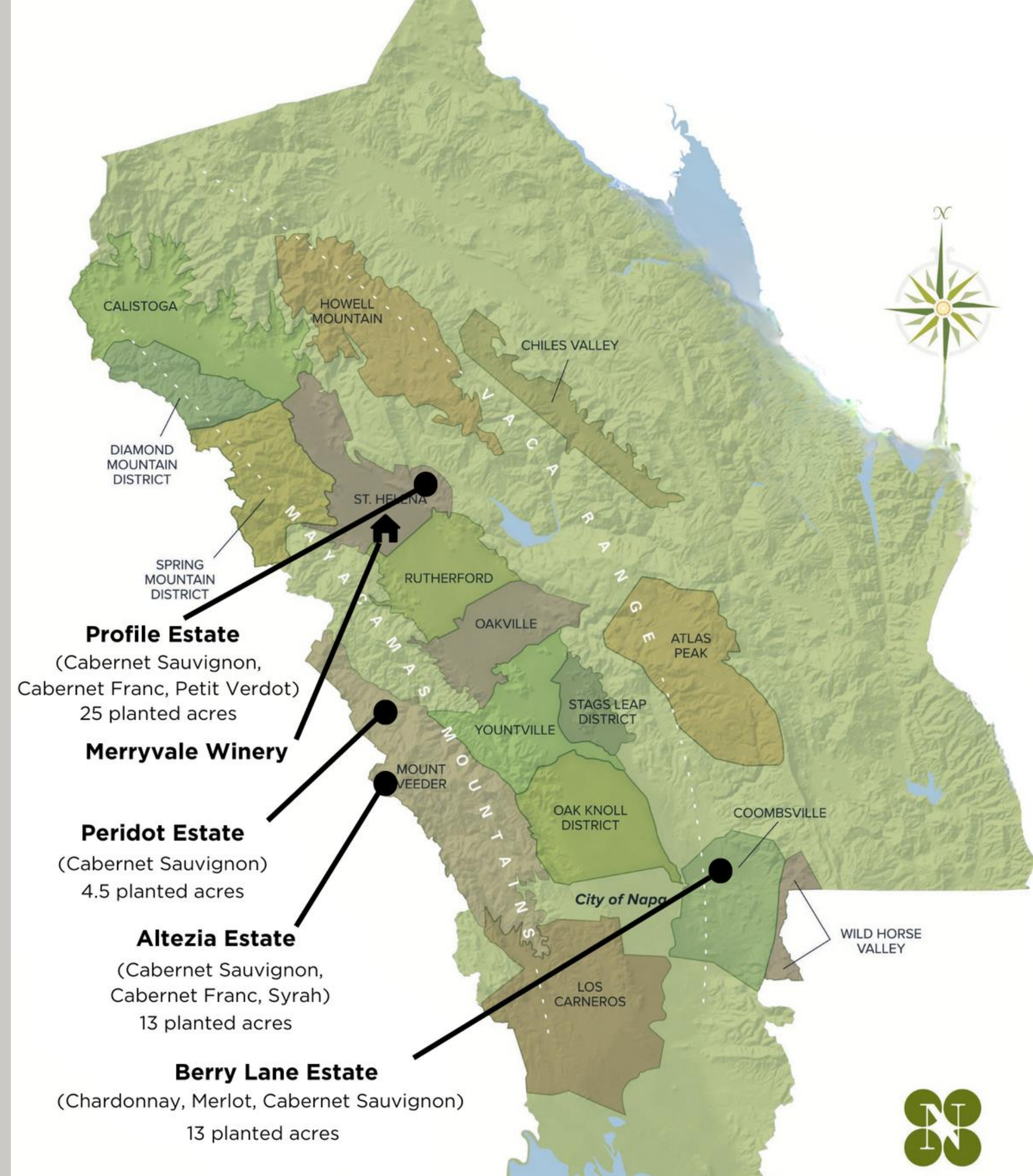
- Hand-harvested, multiple sorting, gravity flow, optical sorter, cold room stabilization.

- Wines that are aged in French Oak creating harmonious, focused and concentrated flavors.

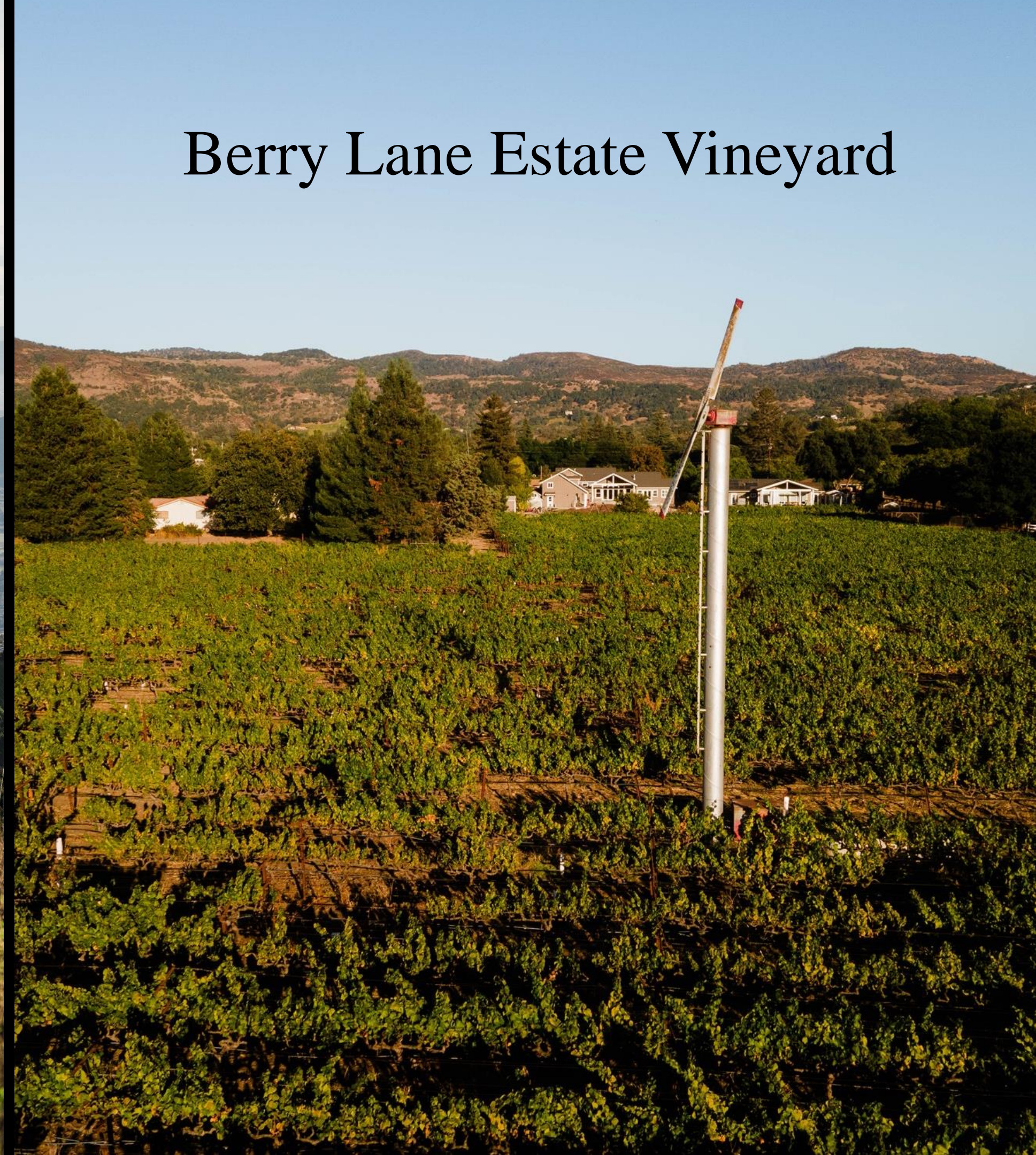

Our meticulous plant-by-plant approach to farming optimizes the varied terroir and rich diversity of growing conditions, which include Forward-Kidd and Henneke soil series as well as gravelly and clay loam. We incorporated sustainable organic farming techniques, such as permanent cover crops, integrated pest management, and zero herbicide use, to elevate quality with every vintage and to preserve the natural balance of the land for generations to come. The Profile Estate Vineyard is certified as Fish Friendly Farming.




# PROFILE ESTATE VINEYARD

- 25-acre estate property in the rolling hills east of St. Helena
- Steep, complex site with a myriad of exposures, soils and growing conditions divided into small blocks based on geology and topography
- A variety of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot clones are grown across the property to bring diversity and breadth to the wine profile
- Developed by David Abreu Vineyard Management with the guidance of Bob Levy and Michel Rolland in 1997

# PROFILE RED WINE

## NAPA VALLEY

Profile is a true representation of our hillside estate vineyard in Conn Valley. Blended from the best lots produced across 25 sloped and rocky acres, it reflects each vintage's unique characteristics through the diversity of clonal selections, rootstocks, soils, elevation, orientation and microclimates on the property. Located east of St. Helena and overlooking the Napa Valley, the Profile Estate Vineyard lies on an eastern ridge at almost one thousand feet of elevation. The steep slopes, rocky soils and volcanic ash bedrock make it a very challenging site to farm, yet this vineyard consistently delivers grapes that stand out for their plush fruit character, complexity and silky tannin.

This hallmark Chardonnay captures the Schlatter Family's vision of crafting an old-world style white wine from Napa Valley. Since the first vintage in 1993, we have selected our very best Chardonnay lots for the Silhouette bottling. This vintage is no exception. Sourced from the best Chardonnay block in the historic Stanly Ranch Vineyard on the Napa side of the Carneros AVA, our Silhouette is a uniquely captivating wine. Meticulously crafted using time honored old world techniques, the gentle native barrel fermentation allows for the full expression of the fruit, resulting in a wine that is elegantly balanced, refined, and complex.

## Sensory Impressions

The 2021 Silhouette is everything we love about great Chardonnay—bright, fresh, full, complex, long and delicious. Barrel fermented with native yeasts in the classic Burgundian style, the wine is unctuous and full while expressing the bright acidity of the cool Carneros appellation. The palate is a delightful blend of honeysuckle, juicy pear, and lemon zest, with a touch of tropical pineapple and a subtle mineral undertone. The fruit is bright and lively, underlined by a creamy texture that gives it a luxurious, well-rounded mouthfeel. There's a gentle interplay between the fruit, the oak, and a precise touch of acidity, creating a long, well-balanced and nuanced wine. An excellent food companion, the wine is also stunning on its own and will continue to evolve over the next 10+ years.

# SAUVIGNON BLANC

## NAPA VALLEY

- 3 months in a combination of concrete tank, neutral French oak 320L cigar barrels and 75-gallon stainless steel barrels

Our Sauvignon Blanc is a very small, hand-crafted and artisan-produced wine. The basket press delivers very low yields but extracts at low pressure giving us only the best juice—the clearest with the highest acidity. The result is a rich, deep Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of stone fruit and citrus. Floral and broad on the mouth; a wine that will get better for a few more years and that is meant to be enjoyed with food.

Aromas of lemon curd, danjou pear, and golden delicious apple burst from the glass. A brilliant example of what Sonoma Coast fruit can offer, the wine is simultaneously layered and complex while alive with freshness and vibrancy. Barrel fermentation in 30% new and 70% neutral French oak provides a medium richness while the natural acidity shines through. Long, lingering, and an excellent companion with food. Enjoy now and over the next 5 years.

This wine exemplifies the powerful elegance of Carneros Pinot Noir. Classic Burgundian techniques in the cellar respect the purity of the fruit and allow for a true expression of a fantastic 2021 vintage. The complex aromatics have it all—underforest earthiness with a core of black cherry and baking spices, complemented by flinty minerality. Velvety on the palate, the wine is perfectly weighted with incredible natural acidity and a long, evolving finish. One of our favorites from a truly outstanding vintage. Drink now and over the next 10 years.

The palate shows great freshness and soft tannins, the hallmarks of a beautiful cool climate Merlot with great drinkability; a great food wine. The wine is incredibly soft and pretty with a balanced acidity. Drink now and over the next 10 years.

Our 2018 Napa Valley Cabernet is a wine truly representational of Napa Valley and the vintage. All the fruit was sourced from pedigreed vineyards spanning several appellations, soil types, and microclimates.

Bright, fresh and vibrant while rooted with a savory core, this is pure Napa in a glass. Aromas of leather, tobacco, cassis, and dried herbs dance with savory spices and blue fruits. The wine unfolds in layers, showcasing a finesse that belies its power. Long, complex, and extremely pleasurable, this wine is a crowd pleaser now, yet will continue to evolve and improve over the next 10 years.

- Produced using the solera process, a system of fractional blending over a number of vintages—in this case, over decades.
- Initially crafted at Beaulieu Vineyards by iconic Napa Valley winemaker André Tchelistcheff in the 1960s
- Aged in French oak barrels

Golden/amber in color from its long aging in French oak, the wine is a complex combination of nuts and orange-peel aromas. Thick and rich in the mouth, the nuts and orange-peel theme continues from the entry through the long finish, highlighted by the many subtleties from the fine brandy and time in the barrel.

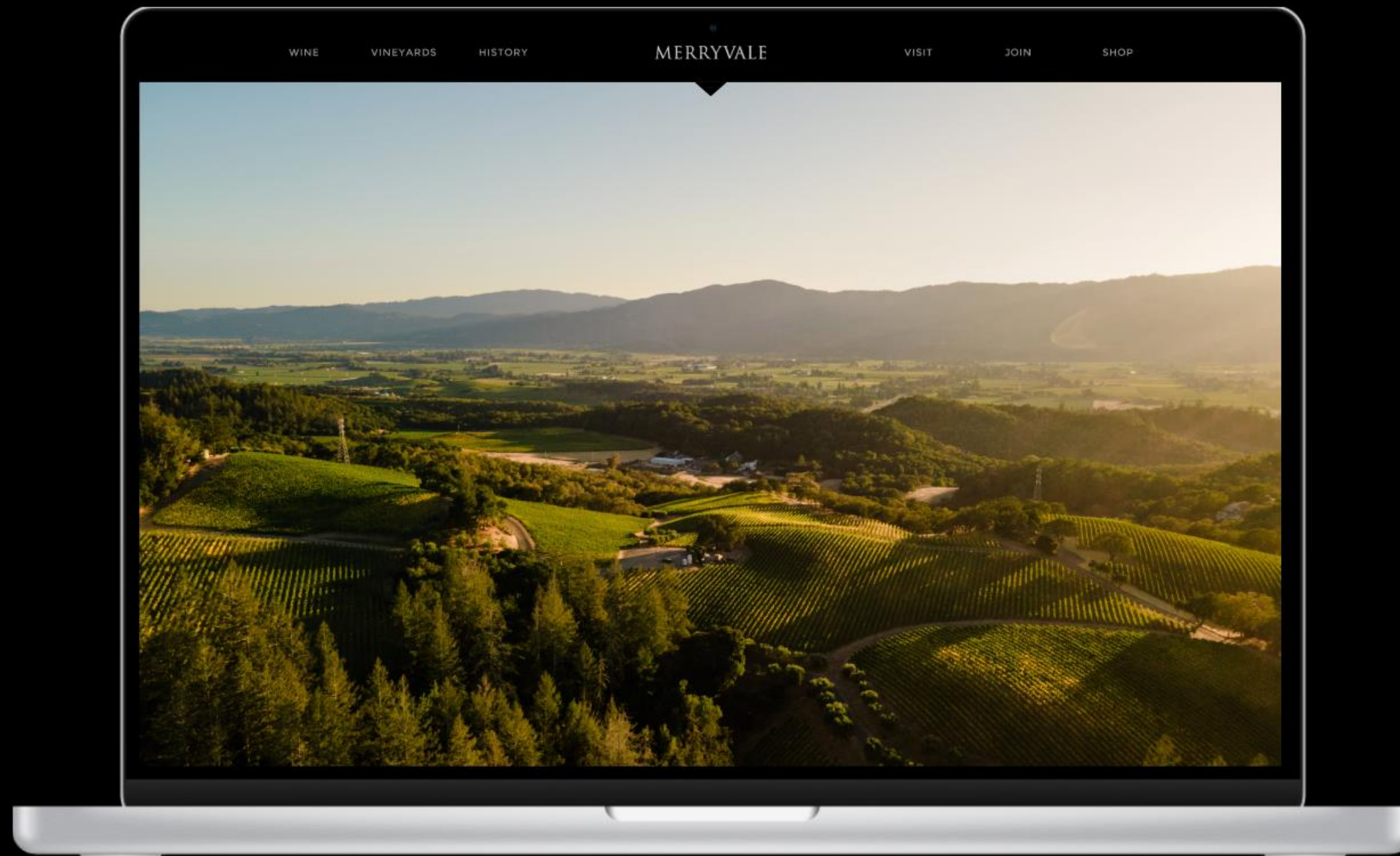

He emphasizes balanced, subtle wines at Starmont, producing standout Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sauvignon Blanc, and Pinot Noir. Jeff holds a Level 3 WSET Certificate and continues to expand his knowledge. He lives in Napa with his wife, also a winemaker, and enjoys traveling, beer brewing, and coffee roasting.

# SAUVIGNON BLANC

Our goal for Starmont Sauvignon Blanc is complexity on the nose with fresh aromas and flavors highlighted by citrus, floral and tropical notes. The 2023 has notes of lime zest, kiwi, guava and honeysuckle. On the palate, the wine opens with a zesty pop and settles into a bit of creaminess on the mid-palate from the neutral barrel fermentation, then finishes quite brightly with green citrus notes that are long and pleasing. This wine can be enjoyed either on its own or with food and is meant to drink in its youth.

Starmont Chardonnay is crafted to enjoy with food or simply by the glass. Our aim is to retain the focus on the unique Chardonnay fruit expression from some of California's top cool climate winegrowing regions. Aromas of Citrus notes of lemon zest with apricot stone fruit exude from the glass, the florality of white rose and slight herbal character of lemon grass all combine to create an extremely complex nose. On the palate the wine is generous with a creamy mid-palate pointing to the sur lie aging, but the cool climate growing regions are showcased with fresh acidity that leaves a crisp, lingering finish. A beautiful and well-balanced Chardonnay.

Our goal for Starmont Pinot Noir is varietal typicity and balance, with just the right amount of restraint to achieve a fresh, elegant example of Pinot Noir from California's top cool climate winegrowing regions. The 2021 brings through bright red cherry aromas that are complimented by a subtle herbal undertone of fresh fennel and mushroom laden forest floor all of which are nicely framed by a hint of cigar box pointing to the light use of new French oak. The palate displays a fresh brightness with a bit of structure provided by soft tannins on the mid-palate and then develops into a long, pleasing finish.

Our goal for Starmont Cabernet Sauvignon is richness and balance, with just the right amount of restraint to achieve a fresh, elegant example of Cabernet Sauvignon from California's North Coast winegrowing region. A complex medley of aromatics ranging from crushed mixed berries and fresh rhubarb to savory elements of dried sage and white pepper, all of which are underpinned by a dark chocolate note. On the palate, the wine begins with a focused precision that gives way to plush density on the mid-palate which is framed by round tannins that melt into a long, juicy finish.
