## PRESENTATION OF SAINT-JOSEPH APPELLATION

The Saint-Joseph vineyard extends over 26 communes in the Ardèche and the Loire Ardèche and the Loire and totals 1300 hectares. The hillsides are made up of rough granite slopes that offer beautiful views offer beautiful views of the Alps and the Mont Pilat. In red, the single grape variety is Syrah.



### *Red SAINT-JOSEPH*

**Surface of production :** 5 Ha

**Soil :** Granite. 75% in the middle of the slopes and 25% at the top of the slopes

**Grape variety :** Syrah 100%.

**Density :** 6 500 to 10 000 vines/Ha

**Year of plantation :** 1985

**Yield :** 40HI/Ha

**Harvest :** Manual

**Barrel aging :** 12 months in barrels (from new to 4 wines)

### *Tasting*

**Color :** Garnet red with purple reflections.

**Nose :** Bright red fruits, good maturity with delicate spicy notes.

**Taste :** Good structure, remarkably balanced, fat, good expression of the terroir with notes of blackcurrant and raspberry.

**Tasting temperature :** About 17°C

**Food pairing :** This wine is perfect with grilled poultry and some cheeses.
